Schuyler has spoken at dozens of events throughout the United States. His speaking experience spans elementary schools, high schools and college auditoriums with audiences ranging from a handful to nearly 1000. He's spoken at nonprofits, corporations, and government organizations, including such hallmarks as USA Swimming, the NCAA, State Street Bank, Gartner Group/CEB, the Massachusetts Senate, etc. His talk has even been offered as continuing education by one national non-profit. His speaking is focused on education, awareness and inclusion and resonates with audiences of all ages and backgrounds.
