



Schuyler Bailar Tour: Reserve your date

Schuyler Bailar, inspirational speaker and inclusion advocate is visiting schools across the country that would not otherwise have the means to host an internationally acclaimed speaker.

Schuyler Bailar was one of the nation's top 20 15-year-old breast stroke swimmers. By 17, his relay team set a national age group record. A 25-time National Championship Qualifier, a two-time All-American, he swims for Harvard University. Schuyler is also the first openly transgender athlete to compete in any sport on an NCAA Division I men's team. Schuyler's difficult choice – to transition while potentially giving up the prospect of being an NCAA Champion – as a female swimmer – was historic and timely. His story has appeared everywhere from *The Washington Post* to *60 Minutes* and *The Ellen Show*.

Schuyler's story explores the universal challenges of trying to "fit-in" in our media-rich world with integrity and authenticity. He explains his struggles and why he ultimately chose to put many potential accolades at risk to be true to himself. Because he has lived his life from many perspectives – woman, Korean American, mixed-race, gay, trans, "Harvard white guy" – his story resonates with young and old, from all walks of life.

Schuyler has visited scores of schools, conferences, and organizations across the country, sharing his inspiring story and changing lives. His appearances have all been by request through word-of-mouth.



For 2019, Schuyler will continue his on-request visits, but he also plans to tour schools and organizations that might otherwise not have the exposure or the means to invite him. The tour will reach across socio-economic and geographic spectrums: from Cleveland to St Louis, from Anaheim to Aurora and from Portland to Wichita – and more.

EVENT FORMAT

Travel plans are being finalized – ACT NOW.

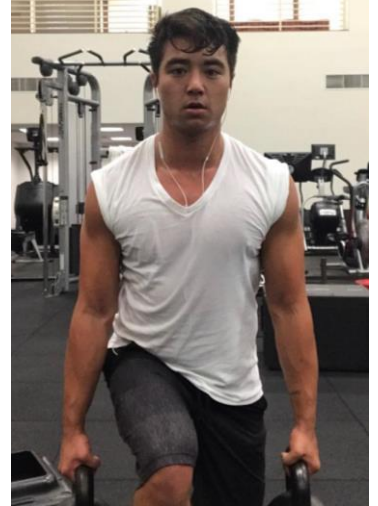
LOCATIONS (Confirmed events in the following cities – still booking more)

ORGANIZATIONS

COSTS

Qualifying schools and organizations will be asked for a \$100 honorarium to defray travel expenses. Sponsorships are available for those who cannot secure funding. The intention is to defray costs for qualifying organizations through other sponsor-hosts.

Help Needed

To pull-off a 40+ event tour in 8 weeks: We need Hosts, Champions and Volunteers.

SPONSORS – Schools, companies and/or individuals with the means to pay for travel expenses and/or honorariums to allow Schuyler to visit their area.

HOSTS – Teachers, administrators, counselors, coaches, principals and other individuals who can commit to and secure the location and logistics for a visit.

CHAMPIONS – Individuals and organizations who will assist in contacting potential schools and coordinate interest. This is primarily a “networking” role and does not require any commitment beyond putting us in touch with potential HOSTS. Tour Staff will handle travel and event logistics with local hosts.

VOLUNTEERS – Drivers to/from locations, ushers, AV set-up, etc.
